THEMES AND TOPICS ADDRESSED

Accompanied by expert speakers and users, the CPM will state its position on the Minister's objective in Bill 15. The French Patient Experience Institute defines patient experience as "the totality of **interactions and situations experienced** by people or their entourage during **their healthcare journey**. These interactions are shaped both by **the organization of this journey** and by the **life history** of the individual in question."

Placing patients at the heart of the system means considering all of their needs, both upstream and downstream of a consult or hospitalization, which implies proximity of care, coordination of care and services, community mobilization, etc.

The current care trajectory most often involves several care and service providers at various locations and times. This mapping often seems complex for the patient and becomes a real obstacle course.
