THEMES AND TOPICS TO BE ADDRESSED

Accompanied by expert speakers and users, the CPM will state its position on the Minister's objective in Bill 15. The French Patient Experience Institute defines patient experience as "the totality of **interactions and situations experienced** by people or their entourage during **their healthcare journey**. These interactions are shaped both by **the organization of this journey** and by the **life history** of the individual in question."

Placing patients at the heart of the system means considering all of their needs, both upstream and downstream of a consult or hospitalization, which implies proximity of care, coordination of care and services, community mobilization, etc.

The current care trajectory most often involves several care and service providers at various locations and times. This mapping often seems complex for the patient and becomes a real obstacle course.

"Patient Experience and the challenges of primary care" (accessibility, continuum of care, home care), presentation by Mr. Yves Couturier, Ph.D., professor in the Department of Social Work, University of Sherbrooke, scientific director of the Primary Care Learning Network, and Ms. Louise Belzile, Ph.D., is a specialist in gerontology and author of several books.

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"Patient Experience and the Journey of Family Caregivers in Long-term Care," presentation by Mr. François Aubry, Ph.D., Professor, Department of Social Work, Université du Québec en Outaouais, Researcher at the Research Centre of the Institut universitaire de gériatrie de Montréal, and by Ms. Josée Grenier, Ph.D., Associate Professor, Department of Social Work, Co-Leader of the Master of Social Work program, St-Jérôme campus.



"Digital technology for the benefit of patient experience": measuring patient experience at the CISSS de la Côte-Nord, including participation in a pilot project. BILL 15, THE COMMITTEES ARE CONCERNED

With its restructuring of the healthcare network, the Ministry of Health and Social Services has brought about unanimity on at least one theme: the feeling of uncertainty and anxiety felt by the members of the affiliated committees and their resource persons. Indeed, with the plan to cut some one hundred committees, thus adding disproportionate tasks to the resource persons who will inherit the facilities and missions without committees, reducing the voice of the patients and their influence within the facilities, which are thus cut off from their representatives. Let us hope that, as the CPM and others have requested, the proposed legislation will be amended to put the voice of users back at the heart of the life of every healthcare institution in Quebec.
