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## LACK OF HUMANITY REGARDING PARKING RATES FOR PATIENTS UNDERGOING TREATMENT

The CPM received information on distressing problems for patients receiving daily or weekly treatments in oncology, dialysis or neonatal care. Some CIUSSSs and CISSSs have offered fee reductions of up to 50%, but more is needed.

Even with such a discount, these patients' parking expenses can soar by several tens of dollars and easily exceed \$50 monthly.

Many users, caregivers and families, already overwhelmed by the situation that afflicts them, do not have the means to pay the reduced rate.

Circular no. MSSS 2020-019 (section 34) authorizes the CIUSSSs and CISSSs to establish special measures for various clientele, including frequent users and users demonstrating an exceptional humanitarian necessity. As if to add insult to injury, several CIUSSSs and CISSSs also show net parking revenues of several million dollars in their financial statements.

Patients requiring regular daily or weekly treatment in oncology, dialysis or neonatology should not have to pay any fees when they come to the care facility. The CPM has made representations on the subject and awaits a response before pursuing the matter further.

# USERS ARE HAVING DIFFICULTIES WITH THE EMPLOYMENT SERVICE PAYCHEQUE

The CPM has received several complaints from users. They are not satisfied with the service provided by the CLSC, which could be faster and simpler. Several service providers are without wages. It negatively affects service providers who resent not being paid and users who badly need their services.

A complaint has been lodged with the Minister of Health, responsible for home care. If no progress is made soon, the CPM will consider further action.
