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BILL 15 — AN UPDATE

For the benefit of committees, here is a brief update on Bill 15, An Act to make the health and social services system more effective:

- All existing users' and residents' committees will go on.
- The new National Users' Committee will allow three members to represent them.
- The function of the National Users' Committee will be to support the committees instead of overseeing them.
- No seats are currently allocated to representatives of users' or residents' committees on the Board of Directors of *Santé Québec*, nor on the institution councils, risk management committees, and watchdog (vigilance) committees.
- The role of users' committees in assessing independently user satisfaction has been withdrawn. It will be vested in the institution.
- A new paragraph was added to section 147 at the specific request of the RPCU. It will allow long-term facility employees to be members of residents' committees as long as they are family caregivers. The CPM strongly objected to this addition, and a discussion is underway among the CPM Board of Directors. We await the final version of section 147 of Bill 15 to decide what to do next.
- The CPM also will continue to call for improved funding for the committees.

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LACK OF HUMANITY REGARDING PARKING RATES FOR PATIENTS UNDERGOING TREATMENT

Management of the CISSS de Lanaudière continues to refuse or neglect to offer free parking to patients in oncology, dialysis and neonatalogy who frequenty visit hospitals in the CISSS de Lanaudière territory. Yet, the CISSS de Lanaudière's latest financial statements show a surplus of revenues of \$ 4,000,000 from parking fees. If other committees face the same predicament, please let us know.

USERS ARE HAVING DIFFICULTIES WITH THE EMPLOYMENT SERVICE PAYCHEQUE

Many users, registered in home care programs, are still waiting for an improvement in the operation of the employment-service paycheque. Some users are not receiving the essential care and services they need because the CLSCs and the Ministry of Health are slow to correct their practices. Complaints have been lodged with both the Protecteur du citoyen and the Ministry. The MSSS has committed itself to correct the situation, but it doesn't seem to be urgent in their mind. We will continue to fight for theses users' rights.
