In the matter of the class action pending in the Quebec Superior Court, CPM has requested that all complaints coming from public CHSLD concerning Covid-19 be reunited in the same pending class action.

Though, complaints concerning private premises will still be dealt with through the complaint already filed at Commission des droits.

We will keep duly registered members and families informed of coming steps in those matters, in the coming weeks.

The right to air conditioning or appropriate ventilation and the right to be safe and comfortable in each of resident's room

Thank's to your collaboration, the fight to get air conditioning or appropriate ventilation and fresh air in each of resident's room has

been successful. To be safe and comfortable is part of anyone's constitutional rights to dignity and safety.

The fight continues in private CHSLD and Nursing homes since a lot of those premises still have not supplied residents with comfort and safety, especially in times of heat waves.

Please let us know if your situation or the one of your love one is still problematic so that we can go on fighting for those rights.
