OTHER MATTERS CPM IS CURRENTLY ADVOCATING

- Decision by the Ombudsperson concerning free parking for users undergoing cancer, dialysis and neonatal treatment, which some CIUSSS and CISSS CEOs are still refusing to grant; the Ombudsperson has resolved to intervene and has asked the CISSS concerned to implement its three recommendations:
 - R.1 Inform the staff members involved in the renal insufficiency unit of the terms and conditions of the transport-accommodation program that apply to their users.
 - R.2 Add to the CISSS de Lanaudière website all the relevant information on the transport-accommodation program.
 - R.3 Add to the CISSS de Lanaudière website the parking rate structure.

Demonstrate that it has successfully taken steps to achieve this objective by February 23, 2024.

- For a more efficient system of home care employment-service paycheque, for which we are still waiting to hear from the Ministry of Health.
- Following information from a committee on the island of Montréal, please inform us of any unilateral decision by which CHSLDs are twinned with hospitals, regardless of location or where or with which healthcare professional the resident is already registered.
- o For a solid public health network and against private agencies.
- o For home care, including medical visits.
